WHEN AND WHERE?

Discipleship groups typically meet on Tuesday nights at 7pm in homes. This date and time may change depending on the group

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

D-Groups will have a slightly different feel from a traditional bible study in a couple of ways. To the right you will find a general 'itinerary' for a typical night at D-Group with brief thoughts on why those elements are included (Group leaders decide what the group itinerary will be officially).

WHOSE GROUP WILL I BE IN?

You will be assigned to a D-Group once you communicate to our pastors that you are committed to joining this ministry. We want to intentionally place a mix of young and old, married and single, newlywed and families with children, together! We believe that in the family of God, you belong, no matter your stage in life! Living in community does not discriminate based on age, and we are to learn from both young and old about how to live godly lives.

SPECIAL EVENTS AND TIMES OF FELLOWSHIP

Groups are also encouraged to consider a night of fellowship once a month, where food and being social are the main event.

THE ITINERARY

7:00 - Meet, Greet, and Eat!

Fellowship is always better with food. Groups are free to make bringing snacks a regular part of gathering together, which could be a shared responsibility among the members.

7:15 - Sing and Pray

We encourage one another through singing and praying. We will sing a couple of songs and then pray through selected Scripture together.

7:30 - Study the Word

The main portion of our time will be spent going through God's Word, verse by verse, with some guiding questions to help us understand the text together.

8:15 - Encouragement and Prayer as Men and Women

After the study time, the men and women will split up for a sharing and prayer time. Why split up? We believe that men are to encourage one another to be the husbands, fathers, brothers and sons that God has called them to be. So too, we believe the older women are to teach the younger, and that they are to mutually encourage each other to be godly wives, mothers, sisters and daughters. Splitting up and praying as men and women gives us opportunity to follow these biblical principles.

THE NEXT STEPS...

Once I receive confirmation of your interest, you will be assigned to a group, and given the location, and time. If you are willing to host a group in your home (no pressure here) please let us know! Hosting simply means opening your home. You are not entertaining, and you will not be asked to prepare food.
